

SCHOOL RULES

It is the right of all staff and students to live work and grow in peace and safety, and the rules of the school are formulated with this in mind.

- 1) It is illegal for anyone under 18 to buy alcohol in the UK. This means that any student who is found drinking, buying or attempting to buy alcohol or with alcohol in their possession may be suspended or even expelled from the school at the discretion of the Principal and Proprietor. All students are required to sign an alcohol contract on arrival at Newbury Hall.
- 2) Newbury Hall has a zero tolerance policy on bullying.
- 3) Smoking is strictly prohibited on school premises for all students studying at Newbury Hall.
- 4) Mobile phones must only be used with the express permission of the teacher.
- 5) Full and correct uniform must be worn during the hours of the school day.
- 6) Full attendance is a school requirement. Any request for absence must be submitted to the Principal for approval at least 7 days in advance.
- 7) Absence due to sickness must be authorised by a Houseparent or the Student Services Manager.
- 8) Students are expected to be punctual for all lessons and meetings.
- 9) Homework must be done, handed in on time and be of an acceptable standard. Students who do not hand in homework on time or who hand in incomplete or poor quality work will attend extra prep sessions.
- 10) No eating or drinking is permitted in classrooms apart from water.
